

## **CAMPERVAN DO'S AND DON'TS**

## DO'S

- DO keep a clear separation distance of 3 meters between all caravans / campervans at all times.
- > DO make sure to the correct Campervan / Caravan supplementary pass is displayed in the vehicle as below:
  - <u>Campervan</u> The mirror hanger needs to be clearly displayed in the windscreen of your campervan.
  - <u>Caravan & Car</u> The mirror hanger needs to be clearly displayed in the car/towing vehicle and the other pass must be displayed in the window of the vehicle at all times. Both parts are required for this pass to be valid.
- > DO ensure that gas cylinders are fitted within the campervan/caravan. Cylinders should only be stored in the unit's gas locker; and must be 7kg or less.
- > DO use the designated BBQ areas using only disposable BBQ's and permitted cooking stoves (Gas BBQ's are not permitted).
- > DO ensure all litter are put into bins or recycling bins.
- > DO ensure Campervan/Caravan ticket holders use the toilets provided in the campsite and not pollute streams or hedges.

## **DON'TS**

- **DON'T** park your vehicle in the fire lanes at any time.
- DON'T move your vehicle once it is parked.
- **DON'T** bring additional vehicles into the Campervan / Caravan site. Only one towing vehicle per caravan is permitted. Additional vehicles must be parked in the general car parks.
- **DON'T** bring a generator, the only exception is a diesel generator correctly fitted within the campervan.
- **DON'T** take your BBQ into your caravan / campervan or canopy, carbon monoxide is a silent killer. Use the designated BBQ areas.
- **DON'T** erected tents or awnings in the campervan/caravan fields.
- **DON'T** use any large garden type furniture such as chimineas; fire pits; large wood burning stoves or any other item that is deemed to pose a risk to the safety of you or other campers at any time. We reserve the right to confiscate these items and/or refuse entry to the campervan/caravan area.
- > DON'T conduct any kind of trading from campervans/caravans as it's not permitted.
- **DON'T** dispose of any wastewater (grey waste) by pouring it onto the ground, into a sump, or into a stream. Instead, use the provided containers for proper disposal.
